

City Council Proceedings

The Plankinton City Council met in special session on Wednesday, May 1, 2019. Mayor John J Staller called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. Roll call recorded the following members present: Pam Vissia, Brad Kehn, Susan Steele, Jim Hinckley & Terry Schuldt. City employee present was Jeanette Smith. City Attorney James D Taylor, P.C. & Ryan J Loker, J.D. Associate Law Clerk. Representing South Dakota Mail was JP Studeny.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Hinckley moved to approve the agenda, with a second from Schuldt. All voted aye, motion carried.

During public comments, JP Studeny requested to have two other agenda items moved before the executive session. His request was approved.

Steele & Schuldt shared information regarding the status of summer lifeguards. They have interviewed two more applicants, Lauren Bruinsma & Mallory Bohr. Lifeguard positions & wages will be discussed at the next regular meeting.

Kehn moved to accept a quote for \$3061.23 from TJ Scott to clean up a nuisance property at 107 S Duff. Vissia seconded the motion. All voted aye, motion carried.

At 6:43 pm, the Mayor asked for a motion to enter executive session, per SDCL 1-25-2(1) & SDCL 1-25-2(3). Vissia moved, with a second from Steele. All voted aye, motion carried.

At 8:20 pm, the Mayor declared to enter back into regular session, with no action taken.

A time of discussion was held regarding zoning. No action taken.

The Mayor adjourned the meeting at 8:40 pm.
