The Plankinton City Council met in a Special Meeting on Tuesday, December 17, 2019. Mayor Staller called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Members present: Pam Vissia, Brad Kehn, Susan Steele, Jim Hinckley, Terry Schuldt, and Jason Schurz.

Motion to approve Agenda by Kehn, and seconded by Hinckley. All voted aye. Motion Carried.

Mayor Staller moved to go into Executive Session- Personnel, as per SDCL-1-25-2(1). Motion by Kehn, and seconded by Hinckley to enter into Executive Session at 7:03 p.m. All voted aye. Motion carried.


Council exited Executive Session at 7:10 p.m., with no action taken.
